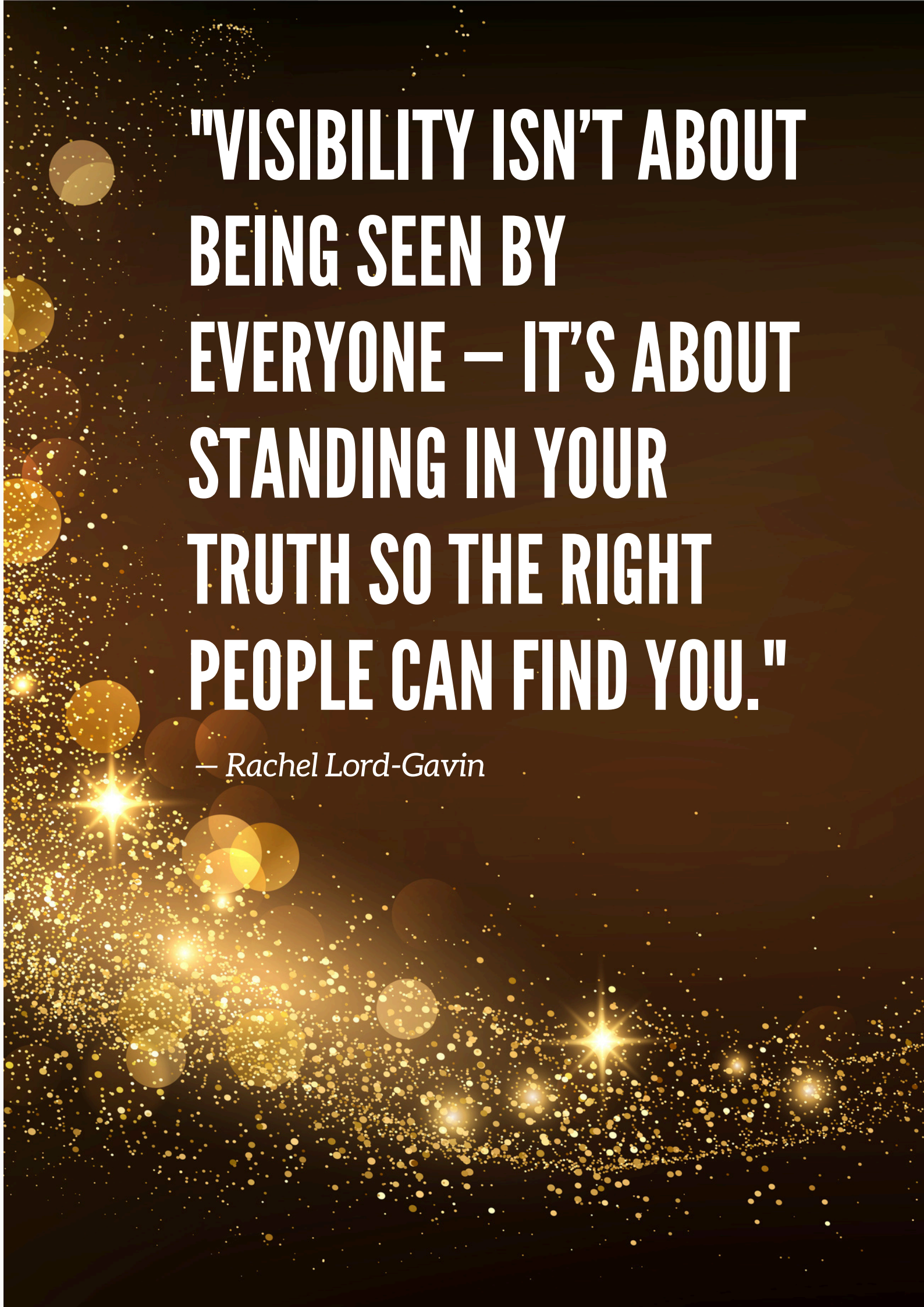

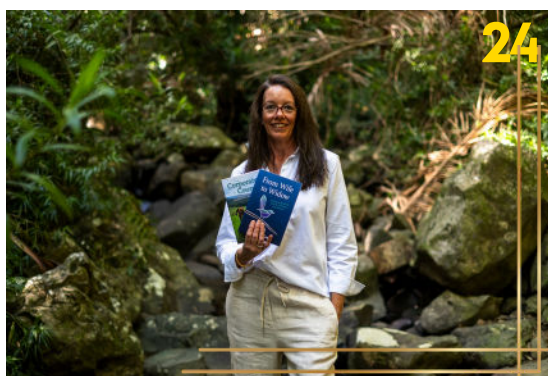

We sat down with Rachael to uncover the story behind the lens — a journey of loss, liberation, and legacy.

With unapologetic truth and soul-soaked rebellion, she's built more than a brand — she's built a movement. Through her lens and her leadership, Rachael doesn't just help women show up online — she helps them rise.

In this powerful conversation, she shares the moment that changed everything, the challenges that forged her fire, and the devotion that drives her mission: to make visibility sacred, legacy tangible, and every woman feel impossible to ignore.

Your journey is powerful. Can you share the moment that sparked it all—the moment you knew you were meant to do this work?

The very first time I made a client cry because she had never seen herself and thought she was beautiful until she saw the images I took of her.

That moment anchored within me that I am here to witness the transformation of women stepping into their power and to help them share their truth, their message with the world.

What challenges have shaped your path, and how have they helped you become the visionary you are today?

I have faced judgement, imposter syndrome, feelings of not being educated enough and being told I am not the right type of person to be doing the work I do. All of this has helped me to become a beacon for other women who feel the same because I do not let any of those stop me now.

Tell us about the mission behind your brand. What impact are you here to create, and what drives you forward every day?

I help soul-led women become impossible to ignore by capturing their essence and amplifying their message. My mission is to create lasting impact through visibility - so their legacy lives beyond the scroll. I'm driven by the belief that when women are seen, they rise - and generations rise with them.

In a world full of noise, how do you stay grounded in your truth and lead with authenticity?

I stay grounded by coming back to my body, my breath and my why. Cacao, journaling, play with my daughter and deep chats with my husband remind me what's real.

I lead with truth because I've lived it - and I refuse to perform for an algorithm just to be seen.

When you think about living an inspired life, what does that truly look and feel like for you? And when your name is spoken long after you're gone—what legacy, energy, or impact do you hope lingers in the hearts of others?

An inspired life feels like freedom - time-rich, soul-fed, surrounded by love and laughter. It's creating art, raising wild-hearted kids and building something that outlives me. When my name is spoken, I want women to feel seen, awakened and brave. My legacy? Visibility as a birthright. Rebellion as devotion. Love, always.

What's something most people don't know about you, but has deeply shaped who you are today?

When I was 18 my best friend chose to take himself onto the next life. This broke something within me and solidified the notion to always be myself, no matter what and to always ask for help no matter what. This also created a space within me to be able to listen, deeply, to anyone who comes to me with a story.

What's one powerful lesson or piece of advice you'd share with someone currently navigating the messy middle of building their business?

Stop worrying about the how and just do what makes you truly happy. I wasted so much time worrying about the HOW to do things and worrying about what people might say if I messed up when in actual fact my opinion is the only one that matters. Always ask for help. It is not shameful to ask for help.

This was the lowest point in my life - this was my not-so-gracious exit from the corporate world.

After leaving the corporate world, I needed to change direction.

I needed to reset my own internal GPS and change course.

That decision was the beginning of everything. Since then, I've built The Corporate Escapists into a platform that reaches readers in over 100 countries, launched I.N.S.P.I.R.E. Magazine, created The Inspire Awards, and opened doors for hundreds of entrepreneurs to be seen, heard, and valued.

It was the first time in my whole life that I could even take a moment to think of where I wanted to go.

All my life I have been told that you go to school, and if you don't go to university then you get a job - then work your way up the corporate ladder then when you retire you have fun. Is that what I really wanted? HECK NO!

I was at this crossroad and about to change course, and actually listen to what I want, not what I had been told to me and, not what society has forced on us.

So you are probably thinking, sounds good Christine, but how? How can someone change the direction of their life? Well let me share with you some insights of how I did this

Firstly, there is not some magical unicorn that will appear and help you. You are the one that needs to do the work. Sounds harsh, however, the reality is that we are the ones in control of our own decisions, our thoughts, our own stories we tell ourselves. Those are the things we need to concentrate on.

To start, as I love stories, I needed to check in and ask if the stories I was telling myself, are they even real?

Our mind loves to play tricks with us. We can all have the same experience however the way we remember things can always be different from each person.

So when these 'stories' appear, I asked myself, 'Do they serve us a purpose anymore in life? I kept asking myself these questions over and over again.

I had the choice to keep believing in the old story that you need to climb the corporate ladder and then when you retire you can have fun or I could choose to believe that you can do something that you absolutely love and make money from it and have fun in the process.

Well, I chose the latter and now *The Corporate Escapists* is one part of my growing global media empire.

I wake up every morning, so grateful that I made the decision to let go of an old story as it was no longer serving me a purpose.

The next part is listening to our own thoughts. No, you are not going to go crazy, and I know it sounds a little left field, however how many times have you talked yourself out of something? That voice still tries to show up sometimes – the one that says, "Who do you think you are?" But here's what I know now and I get to choose which voice gets the final say. Every time I've chosen courage over doubt, doors have opened.

Some of this might sound familiar and this is only a snippet of the thoughts going through my head at the moment. I made the decision to put on my big girl pants and step up. I needed to, first of all, own my story. Own all the crap, all the poor decisions, all the hardship that has happened.

I made decisions that may not have been the best, however now I see it all as a learning lesson. A big life lesson that is not only going to serve me well, it will also serve my clients.

You may be sitting there right now thinking about all of this and wondering, ok, where to? Where do I go? Well, my friend, the best part of all of this is that you can choose where you want to go.

The key message here at *The Corporate Escapists* is to find and follow your passion and live your best life. We are all unique beautiful individuals and we all have the

opportunity to follow our own pathway.

Your journey is powerful. Can you share the moment that sparked it all—the moment you knew you were meant to do this work?

When I was 15, I followed a friend to an art school open day. We drifted apart in the crowd, and I wandered into the painting studio. The smell of oil paint and turpentine hit me like lightning. I went home, picked up a pencil, and never looked back. That single moment reshaped my life.

Years later, with a baby on my hip, I started an online “artists supporting artists” forum. I discovered I had a natural skill for the business side—organising exhibitions, building online systems, solving problems, and encouraging others. Artists in the group started asking me when I was opening a gallery, but I knew that was not my path. I loved strategy, learning, and helping others grow. That forum planted the seed that eventually became The Artists Business Lounge.

What challenges have shaped your path, and how have they helped you become the visionary you are today?

After art school, I struggled with imposter syndrome and stepped away from painting for a few years. It was one of the hardest times of my life. Returning to art was confronting, but it gave me a deep understanding of what it means to lose and then rebuild creative confidence. That personal experience is what allows me to support artists so meaningfully today.

Tell us about the mission behind your brand. What impact are you here to create, and what drives you forward every day?

My mission is to help artists step into their potential, claim their space, and grow sustainable art businesses, without sacrificing their creative energy. I want artists to stop waiting to be “discovered” and instead take ownership of their careers. Seeing them move from stuck to thriving is what motivates me every day.

In a world full of noise, how do you stay grounded in your truth and lead with authenticity?

I stay connected to my own creative practice and the people I serve. Painting keeps me honest. I also create in many forms -not just artwork, but guides, courses, resources, and even custom GPTs! I follow what feels meaningful, not what looks flashy. Authenticity, to me, is about being consistent with your values, even when no one is watching.

What does it mean to you to live an inspired life—and how do you want to be remembered?

An inspired life is one lived with intention, where your values, creativity, and work are aligned. I want to be remembered as someone who made things better for artists, for women in business, for people navigating self-doubt. Someone who gave others the tools to believe in themselves. Nurturing a creative family is also important to me. It is how I get to be my complete aligned self.

What's something most people don't know about you, but has deeply shaped who you are today?

Most people do not realise I spent years in corporate roles and consulting, alongside my professional art practice. That experience, combined with my creative practice and coaching, has shaped how I approach business. I do not just talk mindset or strategy in isolation. I look at the whole picture and bring a clear, practical focus to everything I teach.

What's one powerful lesson or piece of advice you'd share with someone currently navigating the messy middle of building their business?

Keep going. You do not need to have it all figured out to take the next right step. Progress happens through action. Focus on what matters, take imperfect steps, and give yourself permission to learn as you go.

In 2019, I was widowed at 46, and I didn't know anyone that had lived experience as a widow. I couldn't find someone who could offer me the inspiration, motivation, and support me through my grief, so I decided to create that support myself.

What I offer is what got me through this painful and sad period, and it led me to rebuild my life, my identity, and my two businesses. Life Beyond the Grief is a grief mentoring business which offers clients 1:1 sessions, retreats, group calls, healing, and family constellations services for loss of a person or thing.



SUZANNE READ

LIFE BEYOND THE GRIEF & COOLABINE RETREAT

It's been 6 years since my first husband of 19 years died of leukaemia in 2019.

I went from Wife to Widow in the blink of an eye. A title I thought I may hold in my 80s, not at 46.

I didn't know a young widow, I didn't understand what being a widow was like. All I knew that after 22 years with Robert, that life could never be the same again.

That living on 35 acres by myself, 2 hours north of Brisbane, my family in Melbourne, that this was going to change me. I resigned from my Executive corporate job four months after Robert died. I knew I wanted to build my dream business and I needed to heal, but I hadn't experienced deep grief before.

Yep, I was about to navigate widowhood which was never on my to do list!

I look back at the first two years and it was full of pain, sadness, coping and desperation.

On the outside I was keeping it together. Portraying that I was dealing with my grief. Although on the inside I was a mess.

I was on the roller coaster of happy one day, and in pain and sadness the next. Every morning when woke I told myself that I wanted to live, I just didn't know how to do it.

To get there, I needed support, and I found that in my holistic grief counsellor and my coaches, Those2Sisters.

Firstly, I had to show up for myself. For the woman who deserved more. I had to believe in her, I had to respect her, and I had to love her.

Then it was about forgiveness, to process through the guilt, the shame, the loss, the pain. Allow myself permission to let go of the negative emotions, the ruminations that were controlling my wellbeing.

Then came the steps of rebuilding. Of allowing myself the freedom, the care, the fulfilment. To become whole, independent and create MY life, with solid boundaries.

In 2022 I found love and was gifted my new family. I went to retreats, counselling sessions, I allowed myself to be vulnerable and put trust in the professionals. I decluttered and released my emotions, some relationships, my home, practically my whole life.

I built my two businesses from the ground up, Life Beyond the Grief and Coolabine Retreat and I kept doing the work and showing up for me.

My identity today, and who I have become, is now shining through.

The transformation, and the new woman I am continues to up level.

I provide space for those that are going through challenging times, I heal those that are grieving loss of person or things, and I have opened my property gates to those that need peace, serenity and love.

My transformation hasn't been easy and not everyone has understood my choices.

Because of my grief, and my determination, I am now a more fulfilled, happier and richer woman than ever have been.

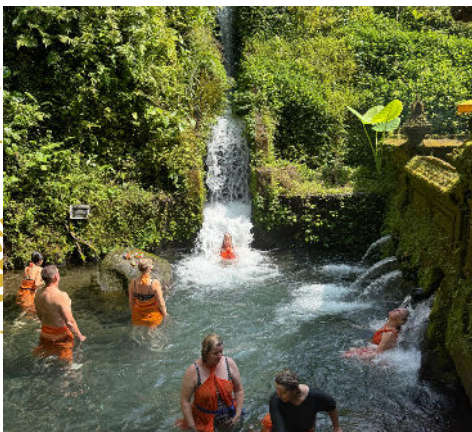


THE RADICAL POWER OF *Extreme Ownership*

What if the most powerful shift you could make in your life wasn't about fixing others, changing the world, or waiting for divine timing?

It's about owning your part, completely.

From the shadows to the breakthroughs, extreme ownership is the quantum key to reclaiming your energy, direction, and inner power.

It might sound heavy at first. We've been conditioned to believe power is granted by the outside world, a title, a role, approval. But real empowerment, the kind that liberates and lasts, begins when you stop outsourcing your life.

It begins with you.

What Is Extreme Ownership, Really?

Extreme ownership isn't about blame or guilt. It's not taking on what isn't yours or over-responsibility for others.

It's about asking:

“How am I contributing to what I'm experiencing, through my thoughts, beliefs, energy, or actions?”

It's the choice to trade blame for embodiment, and waiting for aligned action.

It's when you look at your life, relationships, work, health, emotions, and say: **"I've given my power away. I'm ready to take it back."**

It took me three years to leave my marriage. I was stuck in victimhood, blaming the relationship for my unhappiness. Until one day I chose to take ownership of what I had brought to it. I didn't like what I saw, but I saw it clearly. I needed to change. And that's when I got my power back. The light switched on inside me, and I couldn't turn it off.

"I might not control everything, but I control how I show up."

You Are a Creator Within the Energy

We live in a time of rapid energetic acceleration. Systems are shifting. Truths are surfacing. Shadow work is no longer optional.

But this intensity is also an invitation, to stop reacting and start responding from your truth. To become your own energetic anchor instead of waiting to be rescued.

No one teaches us this growing up:

The more you take ownership of your energy, the less chaos has the power to throw you.



The Mirror Doesn't Lie

Ownership means facing the mirror with honesty and compassion. Asking:

- Where am I giving my power away?
- What stories keep me from stepping up?
- What would I shift if I fully owned my energy today?

Sometimes that means setting boundaries, having difficult conversations, or letting go of victim stories that feel familiar but keep you small.

I spent 22 years serving in the Royal Australian Air Force. As a woman in a technical trade, I was constantly choosing between comfort and integrity. There were times I stayed silent to survive. But over time, that silence chipped away at my spirit. Eventually, I chose to let my voice be heard. I realised it wasn't my job to make others comfortable, it was my responsibility to be authentic.

From Triggered to Empowered

When you feel triggered or tempted to blame:

1. Pause. Breathe deeply into your heart space.
2. Affirm: "I take full energetic responsibility for how I show up in this moment."
3. Ask: "What do I choose to create, shift, or own right now?"
4. Repeat until you feel your centre return.

This isn't about getting it perfect. It's about presence.

Why It Matters

The world doesn't need more blame. It needs heart-led, grounded humans who are willing to do the work.

When you take full ownership, you stop leaking energy into distractions and drama.

You become sovereign. And from that sovereignty, you become a beacon.

Living with integrity and ownership deepened my relationships, especially with my children. I'm able to show them what presence truly feels like.

And it ripples outward to the thousands I serve, whether planting seeds of consciousness or guiding someone into their full awakening.

Responsibility is Empowerment

Responsibility isn't punishment. It's power.

It means nothing is outside your reach. You're not a victim of people or energy. You're a creator within it all.




I invite you to:

- Own your light, your voice, your knowing, your power.
- Own your shadow, what's still healing and learning.
- Own your choices, your energy, and your vibration.

Not from shame. From love. Because when you own it all, you become unshakable.
